YOU CAN REGISTER TO VOTE IF...

- You are a U.S. citizen and are at least 18 years old. Citizens 16 and 17 years old may pre-register to vote.
- You are a legal resident of Florida and the county where you will vote.
- You have not been judged mentally incapacitated.

As a result of the passage of Amendment 4, returning citizens may register to vote if ...

- They are Florida residents and U.S. citizens.
- The felony conviction was not murder and not a felony sexual offense AND
- They have completed their sentences in full, including all fines and fees that were part of that sentence.

NOTE: Voters who wish to receive a **Vote By Mail (VBM) ballot** for 2023 and 2024 elections are **required to complete a new VBM ballot request.**

DEADLINES: You must be registered or update party affiliation at least 29 days before the election in which you plan to vote. **Closing Dates** are as follows: General Election, Monday, Oct. 7, 2024; Presidential Preference Primary Election, Tuesday, Feb. 20, 2024; Primary Election, Monday, July 22, 2024.

3 WAYS TO VOTE

Early Voting

All early voting sites are available to all Palm Beach County voters, regardless of precinct. **Photo ID with signature is required.**

Vote by Mail

Vote by mail (absentee) ballots are available to all registered voters in Florida. Request them online at VotePalmBeach.gov, or call (561) 656-6200. **NOTE:** Vote by Mail Applications expired at the end of 2022 and must be updated. Call the Supervisor of Elections at (561) 656-6200, go online to VotePalmBeach.gov or complete a new form.

Vote on Election Day

Polls are open from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. Voting is allowed in your **assigned precinct only. Photo ID with signature is required.**

PRIMARY ELECTIONS

- Florida is a closed primary state. Only voters registered in a political party may vote for that party's candidates.
- Judicial and School Board candidates are non-partisan and may be on primary ballots. All registered voters (regardless of party affiliation) may vote for these candidates.

SPECIAL FACTS

- If a ballot is spoiled, a voter may have up to two additional ballots.
- A voter who does not show ID or whose eligibility is questioned is entitled to vote a Provisional Ballot that will be set aside to be validated.
- Under the current Florida Laws, requests for Vote By Mail ballots are valid through the end of the calendar year of the next regularly scheduled General Election
